HOMELAND PROJECT OPPORTUNITIES

Hayfork Community Church—Hayfork, CA



Beginning about April 1, this church will be demolishing their old, condemned sanctuary and building a new one. Excavation will begin as soon as the demo is completed and followed by work on the conduit and plumbing under the slab, the

slab, and framing. The number of RV sites available is limited, so definitely check with the Hard Hats office before you make the trek to be sure there is a place for your rig.

Clover Valley Community Church—Woodland, WA

This project is the completion of a new church. Duane Atkinson is the leader, here. The drywall is up and mudding is in progress. The suspended ceiling is underway. Short term housing is available for a couple of volunteers. There is stillroom for one or two RV's on the site.

Callaway Community Church—Callaway, NE

This one is being led by Dennis Korneychuk. He will be building a new auditorium and remodeling the old one. It will need all skills from digging footing trenches to applying shingles. RV sites will be available. Work will begin about June 1, 2006.

Next Step Ministries—SE Indiana

Byron Goodman is the supervisor on a log lodge project. His team will be doing most of the interior framing as well as building the garage and breezeway.

Work will begin June 1 on the main floor sub-flooring and continue for the next three months. There is plenty of room for you RV on the site.



Hands and Feet Ministries—Biloxi, MS

This organization is heading up the reconstruction for the Katrina victims in this area. Everything from demo work to framing, wiring, drywall, etc., is being done here. RV sites are available.

Wishkah Valley Community Church—Aberdeen, WA

This church is planning to put up a new Education building to replace the Quonset hut they are currently using. They hope to break ground next spring and will need all the help they can get. This one is close to home for many of you, so why not join in the fun?

Moreland Bible Church—Portland, OR

Hit by a fire a couple of years ago, the Moreland Bible church will be rebuilding their Education wing from the foundation up. Duane Atkinson will be the key person here. Demolition of the burned shell will begin about May 1 and reconstruction will begin immediately. Limited housing with members of the church is available, so if you live in the Portland area, here is your chance to help your neighbors.



Duck Creek Community Church—Duck Creek Village—Utah

This is a new log building. The subfloor is already in place and they are ready to stack the logs. And put on the roof. It should be quite interesting. RV sites are available.

Pilot Lake Camp—LaPorte, CA

Located in the mountains east of Redding, CA, Pilot Lake Camp is in need of a new bath house. We will need a plumber and a framer as well as someone who is willing to handle the flatwork. Work will not begin until the snow is gone (about May 1) and the bath house is needed in time for the season beginning the first of June.

Cedine Camp and Conference Center—Spring City, TN

Camp Cedine is building ten new cabins over the next several years. They must complete a new one before tearing down an old one. They could really use a team leader to stay longer term, coordinating various volunteer work crews that come to the camp.

Cross Point Baptist Church—Vancouver, WA

This new construction has been underway since last June. They are in need of those who can handle the interior finishing of their new audi-

torium. For many of you, this could be a daily commute. RV sites are available

Young Life Wildhorse Canyon—Antelope, OR

They are about ready to hang the siding on their recently remodeled (so recent it is still going on) staff dormitory. Many hands make for light work, so let's turn out for this one. RV sites are available and the scenery is beautiful, if you like high desert.

Cadence International—Masawa, Japan

Cadence International has a mission house in northern Japan that is in need of a plumber and someone who can do some general repair work. This is your chance to visit eastern Asia and make it count for the Lord at the same time.
